Bridgewater City Council Regular Meeting Minutes January 10, 2011 7:00 pm

The City Council of the City of Bridgewater met in the Council Room for their regular meeting on 01/10/11. The City Council meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by Mayor Martin Barattini. Answering roll call were Mayor Martin Barattini, George Guenthner, Phil Heiberger, Caron Neumann, and Ryan Watters. Absent: Bob Anderson and Verlyn Hudson. Others present: Finance Officer - Joan Julson, City Maintenance - Todd Letcher, Sheriff Mark Norris, Dave & Laurie Keating, Gladys Larson, and Jerry Paweltzki.

The minutes of the December 6th regular meeting were sent to the council for reading prior to the meeting. Motion by Neumann, second by Heiberger to approve the December 6th regular meeting minutes. Motion carried.

The December Financial statement was sent out to the council for reviewing prior to the meeting. After discussion a motion was made by Guenthner, second by Neumann to approve the December Financial Statement. Motion carried.

The bills for the month of December were reviewed. After discussion a motion was made by Guenthner, second by Watters to approve the December bills except for 2011 Dues to SD Assoc. of Code Enforcement, SD Building Official's Assoc., SD Human Resource Assoc., SD Liquor Control Assoc., and SD Municipal Street Maintenance Assoc. Motion carried.

During the Public Input section, Gladys Larson asked the council if a "Loading Sign – No Parking" could be put up in front of the apartments on Main Ave. She feels that with the parking situation, it poses a hazard for any emergency vehicle trying to enter the buildings. Council will act on this request at the February meeting.

SUBMITTAL OF APPLICATIONS FOR INFRASTRUCTURE FINANCING

WHEREAS, the City of Bridgewater has determined a need for a Main Street Sanitary Sewer Improvement project;

WHEREAS, financial assistance will be necessary to enable the City to construct these improvements; and

WHEREAS, the South Dakota Department of Environment and Natural Resources and the South Dakota Governor's Office of Economic Development provide grants and low-interest loans to eligible applicants for financing water, wastewater, and storm water infrastructure projects.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

- 1. The City of Bridgewater hereby authorizes the filing of a State Water Facilities Plan and grant and/or loan applications with the South Dakota Department of Environment and Natural Resources and the South Dakota Governor's Office of Economic Development, including all understandings and assurances contained therein, to fund its water project.
- 2. Be it further resolved that the City of Bridgewater hereby authorizes its Mayor or Council President to act as Project Certifying Officer and its Mayor to act as Environmental Certifying Officer in

connection with the applications, grant and/or loan agreements, and other required forms, and to provide such additional information as may be required by the South Dakota Department of Environment and Natural Resources and the South Dakota Governor's Office of Economic Development.

Due to the weather Vern Arens faxed information on the Main Street Sanitary Sewer Study. The project is scheduled to be placed on the State Water Plan at the March 24th SD DENR Board meeting. The project would be eligible for determining the SD DENR grant and loan funding at the June 23rd SD DENR Board meeting. This would make the project in line for late summer or early fall construction.

Motion by Guenthner, second by Heiberger to not accept the proposal to lease the city bar from HCMJ, Inc - Chris Meyer and to continue our search and running of the city bar. Motion carried. **Contracted Law Enforcement:** Monthly report for December was received and noted. Sheriff Norris was here for any questions. Complaint on barking dogs was discussed.

<u>Fire:</u> Jerry Paweltzki representing the Bridgewater Rural Fire Board discussed putting ceramic tiles in the kitchen and bathrooms in the firehall. Todd will check on heaters in the bay area and gutters. The firehall rent money would be used for these expenses.

Code Enforcement: Addressed a complaint letter on barking dogs with Sheriff Norris.
